1.2 Summary of the Action

Supporting decentralisation in Kenya is a key factor to the consolidation of Kenya as a stable and peaceful national state located in the conflict-prone region in East Africa. Decentralisation processes are seen to lead to better inclusion of the population in key political decisions, notably for service delivery and for recollection and use of resources. The inclusion of ethnic groups, local populations, including woman in all their diversity and communities, and better service delivery offers a more solid ground for peaceful and constructive co-existence, and is thereby crucial to maintain and develop peace and stability. Local governments are key drivers of development, including economic growth, creation of opportunities for private sector and for social services; thereby the functioning of Kenya's devolution process is key to improve future prospects for women and youth.
