RAPTURE Sculpture Proposal

Artist: Cecilia Lueza Art Projects

Inspiration

For Marshalltown's Performing Arts Center we propose a signature, freestanding sculpture inspired by the sky, the flow of water and air and of the different elements of the human form. It symbolizes a state or experience of breathtakingly being carried away by an overwhelming emotion. The artwork evokes a feeling of movement and freedom like those expressed in the performing arts.

Fabrication

The sculpture will be made of water jet cut, welded 6061 aircraft grade aluminum of varying thicknesses. All parts will receive an industrial, UV resistant coating system comprised of an epoxy primer and powder coat finish assuring decades of maintenance free exposure.

Installation

Fasten mounting cleat onto concrete base using Hilti stainless steel threaded bolts embedded into pre drilled holes and filled with HILTI-HIT epoxy. Using a small crane, slide the sculpture onto its mounting cleat and install fastening bolts along the sculptures lowest/ground touching sides.

Timeline

120 days for production.


1 To 2 days for complete installation.






FRONT ELEVATION : Scale 1/4" = 1'-0"




PLAN VIEW : Scale 1/4" = 1'-0"
