In addition to the thousands of ebooks and audiobooks in the Library's Libby catalog, there are over 3,000 digital magazines ready for reading. These magazines are always available with no hold queues. Find *Vogue*, *Us Weekly*, *The New Yorker*, and many more.



Going on vacation? Make sure you suspend your holds in your online Library account before you leave so you don't miss them if they become available while you're gone. You only have 7 days to pick up a waiting hold once you've been notified it's ready. When you suspend a hold, you'll set a date for the hold to 'reactivate' in the queue.



After you receive notification that the hold you placed is ready for pick-up, just pull up to the drive-thru window on the north side of the Library, give the staff person your Library card, and staff will check out and hand you your hold. Keep in mind, unclaimed holds expire after seven days and move to the next person waiting in line.
